S. With reference to the case of the steamer "ITAIMBE" I have to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a cablegram from the Society's Nantes Surveyors stating that the requirements of the survey for classification will be completed to-day, and that the Builders require the classification certificates to-morrow morning. They ask that the certificates in duplicate may be forwarded to you.

In the circumstances I enclose herewith duplicate certificates on the hull and machinery of the vessel, together with a copy of a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Nantes, dated 14th ultimo, setting forth the requirements still remaining to complete the survey, and have to request that you will hand over the certificates in question to the Builders when the fees have been paid and you have received a telegram from the Nantes Surveyors stating that the survey has been fully completed.
