With reference to your letter of the 30th ultimo regarding the Steamer "SKIPSEA", the London Surveyors who were attending the case now say that she will not be coming out of drydock until Saturday next, and that they understand the handing over has been postponed until Monday, the 6th instant. The following items were reported yesterday as being still outstanding to complete the Special Survey:-

All deep tanks to test.  
No.1 double bottom tank to test.  
Forward deep tanks to scale and recast.

The Surveyors add that when these items have been dealt with, a notation of Special Survey will be recommended subject to permanent repairs to shell plating abreast No.2 hold (Starboard side) being effected at the first opportunity convenient to the Owners.
