Dear Sirs,

We acknowledge the receipt of your undated letter which reached us on the 18th March respecting the Steamer "T.W.1".

We regret that there is a divergence of opinion on the question as to whether you were fully informed or not of the Surveyor's recommendations in consequence of the survey of the ship which took place between May and October 1952 at this port.

We can only reaffirm, however, the statement contained in the second paragraph of our letter of the 13th March as we have been categorically informed by the Surveyor concerned that his recommendations were in fact communicated to your Representative.

If you care to call at this office, however, we shall be quite willing to go over the ground with you again in order that you may have a clear picture of what is required to enable the ship's class to be reinstated.
