The class of this ship is subject to cargo battens being placed in order at the earliest opportunity and to permanent repairs to tank top in all holds by May, 1953.

On the 19th ultimo, a request was received from the Owners' Representatives asking that the tank top repairs might be postponed until September next. The matter was referred to the Society's Genoa Surveyors for their opinion in view of the survey held by them in February last, and they recommended that a further examination should be made at the earliest opportunity before agreeing to this deferment.

The Owners were informed accordingly and now reply under date of 22nd instant as per copy attached. I shall be glad if you will give the matter the necessary attention.
