Your letter of the 15th instant addressed to the Corporation of Lloyd's has been forwarded to this Office for attention.

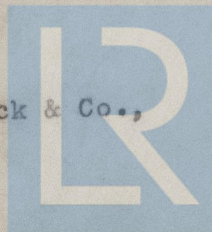
