n(S) (a) I duly received your letter of the 17th instant regarding the tanker "BASSETHOUND" and presume from the circumstances now detailed that you wish to go beyond the postponement for the Special Survey and docking approved in my letter of the 20th January last.

If so the Committee feel that the General Examination held at Manchester in December last ought now to be supplemented by an inspection of the bottom in dry dock seeing that this inspection became due so long ago as July last.

The Surveyors could then ensure that the ship was either found or placed in satisfactory condition for the intended voyage, and could also arrange for the screwshaft liner to be re-examined with a view to postponing its renewal.
