
~~REPAIRS TO ENGINES AND BOILERS DUE TO DAMAGE THROUGH~~

The machinery, boilers and electrical installations examined. All plain tubes in both donkey boilers renewed and electric wiring renewed in part. The safety valves of the donkey boilers have been adjusted by H.M. Dockyard officials in the presence of an Engineer officer and IT IS SUBMITTED this be accepted by the Committee.
