

Ltd., attend their Standard Ironworks at Colchester on 15th May, 1953, for the purpose of examining on completion of machining, one six throw crankshaft Type RPH 2224 suitable for 12 TP Engine Nos. 80853/4 made to the order of Messrs. A & E Woodward Ltd., Hull, and intended as a replacement main engine crankshaft for the T.S. Motorship "DRAKBLÖW".

The Crankshaft was examined in its finished machined state and so far as could be ascertained was found sound and free from defects.
