The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

This vessel was built during the war in 1944 for the Admiralty, type L.C.G (M).

The new Owners desire Classification with this Society while having the vessel converted to a Coaster.

The scantlings and arrangements including alterations as above have been found suitable for the class Al "With freeboard" corresponding to a summer moulded draught of 8'-9" "For Service U.K., Eire (excluding West Coast), Channel Islands and Continent between River Elbe and Brest."

In a First Entry Report and Rpt.8, the BRISTOL Surveyors report (8.51), the vessel examined in dry dock and afloat, the scantlings and arrangements verified and the requirements of a Special Survey for Classification complied with.

The alterations for conversion to a coaster carried out in accordance with the approved plans.

The equipment of anchors and chain cables is in accordance with the Rules and has been tested by the Surveyors to this Society. IT IS THEREFORE SUBMITTED the Figure "1" and Notation of "Lloyd's A & CP" be assigned.

IT IS FURTHER SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to be classed Al "With freeboard" "For Service U.K., Eire (excluding West Coast), Channel Islands and Continent between River Elbe and Brest", to have record of docking 7,51 and Notation of "ss. Shp. 8.51" assigned as recommended.
