In the absence of Mr. Mc.Glashan who carried out the survey and has now left this Port, I beg to state that the Rudder head is 12" dia. and the rudder is of the usual double plate make as fitted in the Castle Trawlers.

The length of the erections are as follows:-
Forecastle 21'0". Raised quarter Deck 71'9" also the floors where solid cement has been removed are flanged.
