Dear Sirs,

I duly received Mr. Wright's letter of the 21st instant respecting the Trawler "JOHN GAUNTLETT", and with regard thereto I have to inform you that if it is intended to utilise the space between frames Nos. 30 & 44 as a bunker, and not for the storage of cargo, there will be no objection to the present arrangement of bulkheads being retained.

It is noted that this arrangement will also apply to the Steamers "COALAXE" and "FIRMAXE", and I shall be glad if you will be good enough to state whether a similar course is to be followed in the case of the sister vessel "GRIFFITH GRIFFITH".
