210 fathoms of the original cable, $1\frac{7}{8}$ " diameter, weight 376 cwts. 2 qrs. 0 lbs. have been replaced on board together with 60 fathoms of new cable 2" diameter, weight 122 cwts. 3 qrs. 3 lbs. ✓

Two 120 fathom lengths of $4\frac{1}{8}$ " galvanized steel flexible wire have also been put on board.
