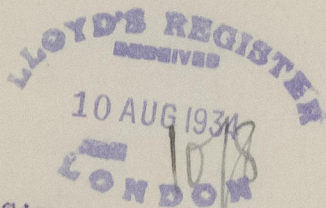

Dear Sir,

As you are aware, the m.v. "HENRY HORN" is at present under survey at this Port for classification in the Society's Register Book. I am today in receipt of a letter from Messrs. Deutsche Werft stating that they have been requested by the Owners to convert the present rudder fitted in the m.v. "HENRY HORN" and the sister vessels into Simplex Stau rudders. Duplicate copies of a plan showing the alterations proposed are being submitted herewith for the approval of the Committee.

Messrs. Deutsche Werft hope that it will be possible for the Committee to approve the plan as submitted as owing to the limited time available the work in connection with the proposed alterations had already to be commenced.
