You may remember that the above vessel was surveyed by you whilst in Drydock at Hull and that Boilers and Machinery also underwent Survey, Messrs. Humber Engineering Co. Ltd., effecting the repairs.

At the close of the Survey you asked from our Principals, Messrs. Marinecraft Constructors Ltd. of 47 Victoria Street, London, S.W.1 particulars of the Vessel's Trading, so that a Freeboard could be assigned. As the Vessel was to be sold by our Principals, they could not give you this information and, of course, from the point of view of a prospective purchaser, for this reason the Survey is not complete.


