Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 30th March 1960 regarding the above vessel we are today forwarding our Reports 8 and 9, No. 66613 on this case.

The future of the vessel is extremely uncertain as we understand that the Owners have instructed the repairers concerned that she is to be laid up indefinitely at this port apparently due to the fact that no purchaser can be found.

In view of these circumstances our reports have been completed so far as practicable. Should a freeboard assignment be requested in the future the relevant particulars will be forwarded when the place and limits of service are known.

We propose to charge a fee of £60 to cover the work so far carried out in respect of the Reclassification and Special Survey of the hull together with an inclusive fee of £30.0.0d., for the surveys now carried out on the Boilers, Steam Pipes and Auxiliary machinery. Before rendering our accounts, we shall be glad to have your confirmation that these charges are in order.
