QUESTION.

You will observe that the Special Survey becomes due at the end of the present month.

ANSWER.

Date:— 6th October, 1953.

The Owners now state that this vessel has been at sea for the past three months and it is not, therefore, possible to hold the outstanding surveys. They request that the Society should grant them a three months deferment of the Special Survey. The Boiler Survey was of course due as far back as January this year.

I propose replying to the Owners informing them that the Special Survey can be put off until the vessel returns from the fishing grounds when, in any case, if the whole of the Special Survey cannot be held, the Boiler Survey must be completed.
