I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th instant, and note your remarks.

To meet your wishes the case was not submitted to the Committee until the 26th March, 1954, by which time the maximum period of postponement for the Special Survey, due in January, 1953, had expired. The class was thereupon expunged from the Register Book for non-compliance with the Society's Rules and Regulations, and as the survey had not been completed within this maximum period, this decision was in strict accordance with the Society's usual practice in such cases, and it is not seen that any alteration can be made at this late stage.
