Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that the Vessels named in your Reports of Survey, numbered below, have been classed as against the same expressed:-

700 "TRANSFORD II". The contents of your report are noted, but I shall be glad if you will state whether the shafts dealt with by you at this time are the spare or the working shafts.

It would appear that the scored screwshafts were replaced at Martinique without repair, and accordingly the vessel's class was continued subject as detailed in my letter of the 27th March last addressed to Mr. Wardle at Aruba, a copy of which was forwarded to you. When the shafts now repaired are fitted in the vessel, a fresh record of Screwshaft will, of course, be assigned.
