


With reference to endorsements dated 25.3.53. and 10.6.53. a letter has now been received from Lloyd's Agents' Surveyor at Fort de France, Martinique, indicating that the scored screwshafts were replaced without repair.

It is not clear whether the shafts repaired at Trinidad are the spare or working shafts, and IT IS SUBMITTED action be deferred and the Trinidad Surveyor be requested to clarify the position and, in the event of the repaired shafts being fitted, state whether a fresh record of survey might now been assigned.
