the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. Trinidad Shipping Co. Ltd., Owners of the s.s. "TRANSFORD II" of Port of Spain, Trinidad, 1736 tons gross, on the 1st. April, 1953 and subsequent date, attend at Messrs. Furness Withy Ltd., Port of Spain, Trinidad, on account of repairs to two spare Screw Shafts for the above vessel.

The shafts, which are fitted with continuous liners, were badly worn in way of same, particularly at the after ends.

Forty and one half inches was cut from the after ends of the liners, and new lengths of similar material shrunk on and Si-feronze welded at the butt of the remaining portion of liner in each case. The finished diameter was 9 1/8" and the inboard end of the old liner was skimmed down to a diameter of 9" full.

I certify herewith that the shafts are suitable for a further term of service.
