Dear Mr. Mayne,

With reference to your letter of the 7th ultimo and to New York Report No. 19830 on the Steamer "AQUIDABAN", I have to acquaint you that Mr. J. L. Denny, the Surveyor in this case, states that the framing in the machinery space, the upper deck stringer and stringer angle at the ends, the hold stringer angle, the forecastle deck stringer, and the stringer angle plating are as approved; that the stiffeners on the oil-tight cofferdam bulkheads are as approved, and it is regretted were not so stated in the report; that the spacing of the rivets in the shell seams is as in the sister vessel; also that arrangements are provided for draining the chain locker.
