I duly received your letter of the 27th ultimo respecting the steamer "AGIOS GEORGIOS" and would explain that the Committee expunged the class of this ship with a red line in November last upon hearing from the Society's Surveyor at Piraeus that her class was being transferred to the American Bureau.

I note you were informed by the Master that the Owners were not entirely satisfied with American Bureau class. This was recently confirmed by the Piraeus Surveyors, and I think I cannot do better than enclose herewith, for your information, copy of a letter dated 23rd February which was sent to them in the matter.

So far as this Society is concerned there was no class restriction whilst she was with us, and we should not of course reinstate class unless we were perfectly satisfied with the drilling Special Survey and consequent repairs for an unrestricted class.

I am sending a copy of the correspondence in this case to Mr. Bone at Piraeus.
