Motorship "SUNNY PRINCE"

This ship is now the property of the Republic of China, having been taken over at Shanghai on the 11th December, 1958.

A notation of hull Special Survey with a date of 9,56 had been assigned, but as a result of representations made by the old Owners, just prior to the sale, it was agreed on the 8th ultimo, to amend the date of this notation to 3,57, and the ship now holds a record of SS Ham, 3,57 in association with CS 3,57.


Official Classification Certificates, in respect of these notations were not issued, pending the examination of Metalock repairs to the forward end of the starboard main engine bedplate, the limit in respect of which had expired at the end of December, 1958.

It is considered desirable that this examination should be carried out as soon as possible, and I shall therefore be glad to learn whether you are in a position to ascertain whether the new Owners desire to retain the Society's Class, and, if so, what arrangements they propose to make for this matter to receive attention.
