m.s. "SULNY PRINCE"

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 11th December together with copies of correspondence received from the Oslo Office in connection with the Special Survey carried out at this Port in September 1956 and March 1957.

The Special Survey was commenced at Hamburg in September 1956 (due date) - see our Report No. 5073. The Surveyor at that time recommended a notation of s.s. (with place and date) upon completion of the survey, and this recommendation was confirmed by the Committee as indicated in your Classing letter of the 9th November 1956.

The ship was submitted for completion of Special Survey in March 1957 and in accordance with the previous recommendation the Surveyor concerned recommended a Special Survey date of Ham 3.57, and a new Loadline Certificate was issued valid for the period of five years from March 1957.

Referring to the 3rd paragraph of the Owners' letter, I have to advise you that this matter has been discussed with Mr. Rose, and he confirms that the survey was in fact planned at the commencement in order that the major portion would be dealt with in March 1957. I am, however, unable to make any comment on the Owners' statement regarding the ship lying at the dolphins here in Hamburg for a number of days prior to loading.
