M/S "SUNNY PRINCE".

With reference to your letter of 25th November, regarding the date assigned to this ship for the last Special Survey ~~we~~ <sup>we</sup> and have conveyed to the Owners the contents of same. We also explained to the Owners that the reasons why the S.S. date was assigned 9/56 was on account of the internal examination of the tanks and drew their attention to the fact that all certificates issued at outports are subject to confirmation by the Committee.


The Owners have now written to the Oslo Office and a copy of their letter is attached, from which it will be seen they are not in agreement with the Committee's decision. We await your comments regarding this case.

The Oslo Office are also in difficulty in this case as we gave to the Authorities the date of Special Survey as 3/57 in accordance with the Hamburg Surveyors Interim Certificate dated 26th March, 1957, with the result that they have issued a Trading Certificate which extends beyond the four year Special Survey period. We feel that in the future we cannot accept the interim certificate issued by the outport carrying out the survey as confirmation to the Authorities that the survey has been held. It would therefore be advantageous to us if in the case of all Norwegian ships, we can be informed as soon as possible after the reports have passed the Committee stage, the Special Survey date assigned. If such can be arranged it would avoid further trouble at this end with regard to the issue of Trading Certificate.
