I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 5th instant with reference to the classification of the above vessel.

Your replies to the questions raised in my letter of the 20th February are noted and this information has been passed on to Mr. Pratt at Whyalla, so that, when our reports and plans have had the Committee's consideration, we will be in a position to advise the Surveyor at Singapore of all outstanding items to be dealt with.

Regarding the fees to be charged in this case - as suggested by Mr. Bennett we have rendered an account to the Owners, for the New York Office to collect, as per attached copy. In addition to the expenses shown in my letter of the 20th February amounting to £49:3:0 there were additional items for cablegrams, photostats and postages of plans etc., amounting to £4:2:6, making a total of £53:5:6 which, at the exchange rate quoted by the Bank here (i.e. 3.2484 dollars to £1) amounts to 173 dollars.
