With regard thereto please be advised that we have now received from the Philadelphia Surveyors a letter dated the 27th instant in which they confirm that the above named vessel has been purchased by South American interests. They also advise that they were informed by the Sun Shipbuilding & Dry Dock Company and it was confirmed by the Master, that the vessel is being transferred to Bureau Veritas classification and that in consequence the Society's services are not now required.

The Philadelphia Surveyors, therefore, in these circumstances proposed to take no further action in the matter unless there are some new developments.
