
With reference to your letter of the 10th instant, regarding Sunderland Report No. 29666 on machinery made by Messrs. George Clark, Ltd., for Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson's S.S. No. 1327, I beg to state that the machinery space bilge pipes have straight tail pipes and accessible mud boxes, all pipes, cocks, pumps etc. are accessible at all times, the pumping arrangements are such as to prevent flooding of the machinery and cargo spaces.

I regret that the report was inadvertently sent away incomplete, and I shall be obliged if you will have the word "yes" written in the three spaces left blank.
