I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant enclosing a copy of a report in respect of a survey on the above ship carried out by a Surveyor appointed by you, and would thank you for your attention in this matter.

The case has been submitted for the consideration of the Committee and the class has been continued subject to deck plating in way of accommodation alleyway (wasted) being renewed by the Special Survey and to all chain cable on board being ranged, gauged and found or placed in accordance with Rule requirements at the Special Survey by the end of December next. I shall be glad if you will advise the Owners accordingly and request them to make the necessary arrangements for these matters to be dealt with.

Fresh records of drydocking 3,57, Boiler Survey 5,57 and Screwshaft Survey 4,57 have been assigned at this time.
