"FU SHING" Schichau Yard No 1400.

With reference to your letter of the 10th instant, regarding the re-adjusting of the safety valves of the above vessel to a pressure of 225 lbs. per sq. inch, arrangements have been made to have this done when steam is again raised on the boilers, meanwhile the boilers will remain empty until the vessel is commissioned.

Regarding the deviation of 5 degrees on the standard compass and 3 degrees on the steering compass, I have been in communication with Mr Schnell and am advised that these deviations were the actual compass deviations, while the deviation due to the effect of switching on and off the electric circuits in the vicinity of these instruments was 17 1/2 degrees on all courses.
