Dear Sir,

We beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th instant, enclosing a copy of one addressed to the Liquidators in respect of the above vessel, and we note that there are no deferred reports.

With regard to the matter of outstanding fees incurred on account of the B. C. Classification Survey, we think it well to advise you that we have been requested by local Consulting Engineers, with the concurrence of the Liquidators, to carry out an inspection of the vessel's machinery on behalf of Canadian prospective purchasers. This survey had been commenced, but in view of the unpaid B.C. fees (of which we were previously unaware) we have thought it well to suspend operations, on the assumption that a prerequisite to the rendering of any further services by this Society will be settlement of all accounts outstanding against the vessel. We shall, however, be glad to have your confirmation of this as soon as possible.

In the meantime the situation has been explained on the above lines to the Consulting Engineers.
