Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines

The ship has been under survey at LE HAVRE on 23rd November 1954 and subsequently :

The 9" French head ventilators Port and Starboard Engine Room skylight have been removed, the deck in way has been closed and efficient compensators have been fitted.

The Boiler Room bulkhead has been pierced and efficiently stiffened at stockhold platform level and and efficient steel hinged w/t door has been fitted, door can be opened or closed from either side and gives access to a vertical w/t trunkway with ladder, to ford, accommodation inside weather doors.

Weather doors are of wood and not less than 2" thick,
