for and cancel the original Report forwarded to you on the 7th instant.
The certificates, test sheets and "As Fitted Drawing" attached to the
original Report should now be attached to the new Report.

We also enclose a copy of an amended Machinery Interim
Certificate B1 which has been issued in this case and have to request that
you will kindly substitute this for the copy of the original Certificate
which was attached to the Machinery First Entry Report.

After consultation with the Principal Engineer Surveyor,
Mr. John S. Heck, it was decided that our original recommendation that a reserve
be made against the class of this ship, viz: "subject to electrical installation
being specially examined before the end of September, 1945", should be
modified in accordance with the terms of the new Certificate now issued, in
view of the use of Polyvinyl Chloride insulated cables above deck contrary




