In regard to the Boiler Survey as the boiler is used for domestic purposes only the Owners state that they do not wish retention of class and this also applies to the sister vessels "CHI MEN", "SHIH MEN", "LUNG MEN", "CHIEN MEN" and "KUEI MEN".

No survey of machinery parts has been possible due to vessel's location.
