
PARTICULARS OF DEFECTS, REPAIRS, ALTERATIONS, ETC.

Attended on board vessel at request of Owners to examine leakage of P. boiler centre combustion chamber.

Found four stay bolts and sootblower pipe leaking.

Recommended to remove nuts of stay bolts, caulk and refit nuts and to caulk sootblower pipe.

Hydraulically tested on completion and found tight.



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The reason for repairs must be stated and those on account of damage, the alleged cause of which must be given, should be detailed separately from wear and tear repairs.
