Annual Boiler Survey.
The sea connections & propeller fastenings examined.
The main & donkey boiler examined & put in order.
All safety valves adjusted under steam.
In consequence of wear & tear, 46 smoke-tubes renewed in the main boiler & 6 pins tapped into the tube plates where these plates were slightly tracked.
In the donkey boiler, 2 new patches fitted on the fire box side, & one on the lower cross tube; & one on the fire box sides renewed.
The shell repaired round two muddoles & new compensating rings fitted in the way of the same.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:—


This vessel's machinery is in good condition, eligible in my opinion to remain as classed, with fresh rotation of B.S. L-94 in the Reg. Bk.
