SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

EAST NEUK (s).—*Dundee, Dec. 17.*—Yesterday morning while the steam liner East Neuk, belonging to the Crail Steam Fishing Company, was returning home from Aberdeen, where she had landed her fish, she struck during a dense fog on the north side of the Carr Reefs. The crew were taken off by the Granton trawler Albatross and landed at Crail. The East Neuk was afterwards fallen in with in a waterlogged condition by the fishing-boat Maggie Smith and taken into Arbroath.
