REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR
 The ceiling & bunks in this vessel's forecabin were removed owing
 to leakage from the deck above. The frames, & shell plating
 have been scaled & the latter found thin locally. Three patches
 have been bolted over the thinnest parts on the star board
 side & one on the port side. This has been done temporary
 but when this vessel is laid up for her next survey in the
 spring, the owner has been notified that this part of the
 ship must be thoroughly examined & the affected plates
 renewed. See a copy of a letter to him, herewith attached.
 It is probable that 2 plates on each side in the 2nd stowage below
 the sheerstrake will require renewal at that time. The owner
 states that he cannot lay this ship up for this survey until the early spring.
