I may state that the 'Express' has been twice ~~altered~~ <sup>lengthened</sup> for painting since being lengthened at Aberdeen and that there is no difference in the keel since that time, had Mr. Kettle in-



formed me that he had any  
doubt about the keel when the  
steamer was being lengthened at  
Aberdeen when she was about  
three months it would have  
been better instead of which I  
only got the information when  
the work was nearly finished
