Sir,

I beg to acknowledge
the receipt of your letter of the 14th
Instant referring to Wing Sang
recently built at this port. Report
of Survey No 3446; and in reply
regret to state, that the statement
on the first entry report, that three
shakes of plating at bulges have
butt straps fitted $\frac{1}{16}$ thicker than
the plates they connect and are
double riveted, does not state all
that has been done, there are
four shakes of plating at bulges
fitted with butt straps $\frac{1}{16}$ thicker
than plates and double riveted.
The discrepancy is purely a clerical
one

one, which I much regret, and
shall try to prevent a recurrence
of the same.
