We are in receipt of your communication informing us that your Committee are taking exception to the weight of small stream anchor of the "Glencoe" - We would therefore feel obliged if you would forward this note asking them if they would kindly reconsider the matter on the grounds that whereas your rules ask us to

supply a total weight of anchors of 13" 3.0 ^{at 90 to} ex stock we have supplied 13" 3.14 ^{at 90 to} ex stock so that although we are rather light on the stream anchor we are more than the difference in excess of your rules on the Tower anchors which are of course the most important - The Equipment No. also if you will observe is only slightly in excess of the numeral for the weights of anchors we supplied - Hoping your Committee will give this matter their favorable consideration We are
