

Tests of 11 Steel Plate manufactured by Messrs D Colville & Sons of Motherwell for Boiler No. 247 to be constructed by Messrs Hall Russell & Co of Aberdeen for their S.S. No 247

The specified in the accompanying copy of Advice Notes were rolled from charges. The tensile test has been applied to samples as set forth below, and the temper and bending tests to a shearing from each plate with satisfactory results.

When a second test is applied, the result should be recorded immediately below the record of the original test. The number of plates or bars included in a rejection must be clearly stated.
