Nature of Survey

Cargo battens

A report of some alterations and repairs carried out at Aberdeen was before the Committee on the 2nd instant, when the vessel was allowed to remain as classed with record of survey, subject to the certificate of classification having the words written on it, "subject to the vessel being engaged exclusively in carrying coal, ore, or wood while without cargo battens."

A letter has now been received from the Aberdeen Surveyors stating they regret having omitted to state in their report that the vessel has been fitted with spar ceiling in the holds.

It is submitted the vessel should now be allowed to remain classed without special conditions.
