With reference to your letter of the 16th instant, enclosing one from Mr. Dimmock respecting the delay which occurred in reporting the particulars of the new boiler recently fitted at Aberdeen on the steam trawler "CHANTICLEER", I have to say that the explanation given by Mr. Dimmock is not considered satisfactory, as the circumstances in no way appear to justify the delay which has been allowed to occur.

I have to point out that the first entry report on this boiler should have been handed in to the Glasgow Office immediately after the survey was completed on the 28th September. Instead of this, however, the report was not received by you until the 7th November, and I have to enquire what notice was taken of this long delay in your Office, on what dates and with what result.
