H. I have to acquaint you that it appears from a report recently received from the Society's Surveyors at ^{Aberdeen} ~~Plymouth~~ on the steam trawler "GHANTICLEER" that the Special Survey No.3 has been carried out at that port. The Surveyors, however, state that as the vessel has been lengthened, an anchor weighing 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ cwt, ex stock, and 15 fathoms of 15/16" stud link cable require to be supplied. These have been ordered and will be placed on board at Plymouth, to which port she has proceeded, and I have therefore to request that you will give the case the necessary attention.
