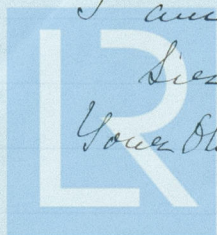
Sir

I beg to acquaint you that at the Survey of the boiler of the Steam Trawler "Charitable" last July I advised Mr. Chant the Managing Owner that when the No 3 Special Survey became due the bottoms of the Combustion Chamber should be renewed and the back flanging of the furnaces efficiently repaired.

He now informs me that when at Aberdeen fitting out a new Trawler for the firm he arranged with Mr. A. Hall & Co. to lengthen the vessel, lift out the boiler, renew the furnaces and Combustion Chamber and turn the boiler round to face from forward, and that the time now being up, he purposes sending the vessel to the above port at once leaving Plymouth on Monday next.
