I respectfully beg to inform you, that it is proposed to lengthen the iron steam trawler "Chanticleer" N^o 614 in Book. and in connection therewith, I now forward an amended plan of Midship Section, together with one of Profile and Deck, for the consideration of the Committee. The additional portion (the length of which will correspond to that of a shell plate amidships) will be of steel, of similar scantlings, to those quoted on original Midship Section, while it is also intended, to carry out extensive alterations to fishroom, and bunks, partly renew the deck, and put the vessel through the Special Survey N^o 3. due in June next.
