I beg to forward herewith a letter received from Messrs Hall Russell & Co Ltd, having reference to the Steamer "Armida", which has been purchased by Messrs De Chanand & Co of Naore, and will, after the necessary alterations have been carried out, be employed by them, in the frozen meat trade to Naore.

It is the intention of the new owners to triple the main engines, by the fitting of a High pressure cylinder 19 ins diameter, on the top of the present H.P cylinder, while steam at 160 lbs working pressure will be supplied, by two main boilers salvaged from the wreck of the Steamer "Isadora" near Cork.

As will be seen from the above mentioned letter it is not proposed to make any further alterations in the main engines, but I would beg to be

informed of the opinion of the Committee,  
respecting the shafting, piston and connecting  
rods and guides.

I understood that the vessel is expected to reach  
this port in about a fortnight, bringing with  
her, the new boilers, and the work on fitting these  
on board, together with the insulation of the holds  
and the fitting of refrigerating plant, will be at  
once proceeded with, while the present intention  
is to postpone the tripling of the engines, until  
the end of the present year.
