Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 22nd Inst., with the first Entry Report on the steamer "Sea Fisher" enclosed, and with reference to the vessel having a raised quarter deck, and the "thought that the plating number should be increased 1/2 to the equipment"; I beg respectfully to inform you that, the steamers "Dunonnell", "Topic", and "Parkmore", (Belfast Reports Nos 2930, 2745 and 2719 respectively) were all sister vessels, having the same equipment; and, as the raised quarter deck is but a very short Break over the Cabin, the same as in the sister vessels, I respectfully submit that the equipment for this vessel may also be approved by the Committee.
