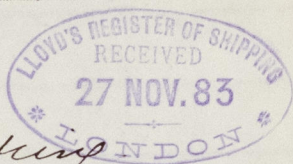

Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 23rd Inst., referring to the depth of the new steamer "Jane Clark", and I beg to inform you that, in compliance with the request therein, I have this day measured "the depth from the top of the floors to the height of the top of the main deck beams amidships", and find it to be 14' 1", taken as follows. -

Height from top of floors to top of R ^d . 2 ^d . deck beams at the Centre of vessel, which is 10' 4" abaft the Break - - - - -	16' 6"
Height of Raised Quarter deck -	2' 5"
	<u>14' 1"</u>

The depth taken in the same way at the lowest part of the Sheer is - 13' 11".

I beg

add that the vessel has just returned from her first voyage, she was not in the port when I received your letter of the 19th Inst., so that I could not verify the figures at that time.

The first entry report is returned herewith.
